“When they were created בְּהִבְרָאָם ” appears in the Masoretic text of the Hebrew Bible with a **small hey ה** and so you wonder why this letter is made smaller and can be clearly seen, reminds me of the hey in the names of Abram and Sarai, when God in His name אלהים Elohiym [power and authority] changed there names by adding part of His in to theirs, to mark and enable them as His servants.

So then has the Lord filled the sky's and the land, has He marked and enabled them? with the "hey," His breath His Character like He did [with the names] Abra**H**am and Sara**H**. **Yes!** He breathed Himself in to the sky and land.... it's another sort of *water mark* in the scriptures of our Creator!

Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham**; for a father of many nations have I made thee. Gen 17:5**
