

I am your Shield

From a primitive root H1598 גָּנַן ;
to hedge about,
that is, (generally) protect: - defend.

also from root

H1588 גָּן a garden
(as fenced): - garden.

H1593 גִּנְיָהּ Feminine
of H1588; a garden: -
garden.

H1594 גָּנָה another
form for H1593: -
garden.



Look back at the root as this gives
more meaning of what the words
DNA carries . Like a plant!

Roots are verbs, thus **action!** Words.
